### **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 7TH, 2023 - 3PM KICK-OFF**

The Iron welcome Brackley Town to Glanford Park for the second time this season, following last month's goalless draw in the **Emirates FA Cup.** 

This meeting between the two sides will be the third encounter and is already set up to be a good contest after the Saints came out on top in a replay at St James Park earlier this month.

Following a stalemate in the opening tie at home, a quick turnaround was arranged at Brackley. Despite Danny Elliott giving the Iron the lead, the hosts on the night, United were down to nine men due to injuries and ended up succumbing to three late goals which saw the side progress to face the other Iron this afternoon in Braintree Town.

Please note, full matchday prices apply and there is no payment on the turnstiles.

Fans are able to pay cash at the corner ticket booth between the Britcon and Mortz Stands, which opens 90 minutes before kick-off.

They have obtained 16 points from a possible 30 to start the campaign. Last time they travelled to North Lincolnshire, they were bang in form, but have since lost two games and currently sit tenth in the table. Indeed, aside from their last three games (including the one today) in the Emirates FA Cup, they will come into the tie having lose their last two league matchs against Scarborough Athletic and Curzon Ashton, respectively.

Last term, the side from Northamptonshire came agonisingly close to promotion to the National League for the first time in their 133-year history, finishing fourth. They were eventually defeated 2-0 in the play-off final by Kidderminster Harriers, thanks to two Ashley Hemmings strikes either side of the break.


