

Academy Goalkeeping Coach – part time

Scunthorpe United Football Club is seeking to recruit a self-motivated, committed, confident and knowledgeable individual to join the Academy in the position of part-time Goalkeeping Coach. The role is fundamental to the long-term vision of Scunthorpe United Football Club in helping to identify and develop elite goalkeepers.

The role includes delivering the Goalkeeping Curriculum within the Foundation Phase (U9-U11) and Youth Development Phase (U12-U16). The successful applicant will plan and evaluate all sessions undertaken in writing and be required to upload the information onto the Premier League performance management tool (PMA), as part of the players on-going development programme and in line with Professional Game Academy Audit Company (PGAAC) audit requirements. The successful candidate will be expected to work on specific weekday evenings and must be able to work at weekends covering both training and the games programme.

The successful candidate will be required to have good knowledge of the game through playing experience and preferably have previous experience of coaching at Academy level. All applicants under the EPPP guidelines must hold the following mandatory qualifications: ***please see job description.***
